

PROCLAMATION

Honoring Habitat for Humanity for 25 Years of Service

Whereas: Habitat for Humanity of Butte County began its service in 1993, and has, with its programs, donors, and volunteers, built 32 homes, helping 31 families move into decent and affordable housing; and

Whereas: Habitat has partnered with the City of Chico, to build energy-efficient and sustainable affordable housing to contribute to neighborhood development; and


Whereas: the business community, individuals, community and faith-based organizations have joined in this effort with donations, labor, and expertise; and community members have donated an average of 4,000 hours of labor per house (which equals nearly 130,000 hours); and

Whereas: 31 families have pledged their labor and their commitment to building and maintaining homes; to creating strong neighborhoods and a strong community; and to contributing to the economic health of our community; and

Whereas: Habitat in partnership with the Restore has diverted nearly 5,000,000 lbs. of building materials and house goods from the landfill since 2004; and

Therefore, be it resolved that I, Sean Morgan, Mayor of the City of Chico, do hereby declare on behalf of the City Council that 2018 will be a year of recognition and appreciation of 25 years of service to our community by Habitat for Humanity of Butte County, the Restore, and by the thousands of community members who have made invaluable contributions to improve the quality and character of our city.
