

Board Director Job Description

Three Legal Duties:

Duty of Care:	Directors and officers must perform their responsibilities in good faith and with the same care an ordinary person would use in managing his/her own affairs.
Duty of Loyalty:	Directors and officers must act in good faith and in a manner that does not harm the organization to the benefit of the director or officer. Avoid any conflicts of interest or appearances of impropriety.
Duty of Obedience:	Directors and officers must comply with the provisions of the articles of incorporation, bylaws, and state laws, and should safeguard Habitat's mission.

General Expectations:

- Know and support the organization's mission, purposes, goals, policies, programs, services, strengths, and needs.
- Give an annual gift according to personal means.
- Attend a minimum of 75% of all meetings.
- Serve as a liaison to a standing committee.
- Dedicate 6 to 10 hours per month distributed among: Board meeting, Committee meeting, Special events.

Job Duties include:

- 1. Manage the affairs and business of the corporation in keeping with the law and the bylaws of the corporation.
- 2. Prepare for the meetings to include review ED reports, financial reports, previous meeting minutes, and any special correspondence.
- 3. Stay informed about what is going on in the organization from newsletters, emails, or media outlets.
- 4. Select, appoint, and evaluate the Executive Director.
- 5. Manage the affairs and business of the corporation in keeping with the law and the bylaws of the corporation.
- 6. Manage resources wisely for the purposes of the corporation.
- 7. Ensure effective organizational planning including budgeting.
- 8. Serve in leadership positions or undertake special assignments willingly and enthusiastically when asked.
- 9. Assess and improve the Board's own performance.
- 10. Suggest possible nominees to the board who can clearly make significant contributions to the work of the Board and Habitat's progress.
- 11. Director reports to the President of the Board.

Terms:

Each Director elected shall serve for a term of two (2) years

A Director may serve no more than four (4) consecutive full terms, but may be elected again after a one (1) year sabbatical.
