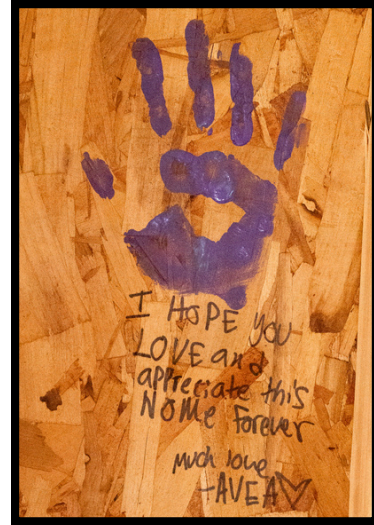


WALL SIGNING
